# Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the City of Northfield Council January 27, 2014

Pursuant to written notice, the regular meeting of the City of Northfield Council was held on Monday, January 27, 2014, at the Fenley Office Park, 4965 U.S. Highway 42. #### MINUTES

## TREASURER'S REPORT

Mr. Veeneman distributed and reviewed the Balance Sheet as of December 31, 2013, for the General Fund and the Budget vs Actual Statement for the General Fund for the period November 1, through December 31, 2013, the Balance Sheet as of December 31, 2013, for the Road Fund and the Budget vs Actual Statement for the Road Fund for the period November 1, through December 31, 2013, and the City's List of Investments as of December 31, 2013.

## POLICE REPORT

Police Chief Richard Frank briefed the council on recent activities throughout the city. He reported that there was no criminal activity within the city during the past two months and that 16 citations were issued.

## NORTHFIELD'S CITY-OWNED LOTS

Mayor Chappell reported that MSD has placed several structures in the area of the city-owned lots. It is estimated that 30% of these structures lie outside the MSD easement. Mr. Joel Latto, Land Survey Manager for Ops Engineering, specializing in public utility easement work, has submitted an estimate to perform a formal evaluation of this property and possible encroachment. Mayor Chappell will consult with City Attorney John Singler regarding this issue but did recommend that the City obtain this report.

It was moved by Mr. Levy and seconded by Ms. Berger that the City proceed with Mayor Chappell's recommendation to obtain a formal evaluation of this property and possible encroachment, spending no more than \$800. Council members voting in favor of motion: Berger, Birch, Levy, Rhea, Walker and White. Motion carried.

# PAY SCALE ORDINANCE FOR CITY EMPLOYEES

Mr. White and Mr. Levy will form a committee to discuss changes in the pay scales for all Northfield employees. An ordinance will be adopted outlining these new pay scales.
