## NUISANCE ORDINANCE AND CODE ENFORCEMENT

Council members again reviewed the proposed Nuisance Ordinance. Attorney John Singler provided answers to specific questions regarding the various sections; particularly Section 2, Property Maintenance Standards. Also, council members agreed to add a misdemeanor penalty to Section 4, Enforcement and Cleanup or Abatement.

Following considerable discussion and amendment, Ordinance 14-05, Series 2014, amending regulations concerning restriction of nuisances, with the addition of a misdemeanor penalty, had a first reading. It was moved by Ms. Berger and seconded by Mr. Rhea that this ordinance be adopted. Council members voting in favor of motion: Berger, Birch, Rhea and Walker. Council members voting against this motion: Levy and White. Motion carried.
