TREASURER'S REPORT

Mr. Veeneman reviewed the Balance Sheet and the Budget vs Actual Statement for the General Fund for the period August 1, 2015, through August 31, 2015, the Balance Sheet and the Budget vs Actual Statement for the Road Fund for the period August 1, 2015, through August 31, 2015, the City's List of Investments as of August 31, 2015, and the General Ledger and Check Register from August 1 through August 31, 2015.

CLERK'S REPORT

CITY ENGINEER'S REPORT

Mr. Hasselwander will obtain an estimate to install electrical service and panel at the corner of Glenview Avenue and U.S. 42 and also an estimate to update the electrical service at the main entrance island.

OLD BUSINESS

SECURITY CAMERAS

Midwest Systems and Services, Inc., has given an approximate bid of \$13,959 to install five security cameras throughout the city. Two cameras would be installed in the main entrance island, one camera at the corner of Glenview Avenue and U.S. 42, one camera at the corner of Lime Kiln Lane and Lime Ridge Place, and one camera would be jointly operated with Glenview Manor and located at the Lime Kiln Lane and Glenwood Road entrance.

NORTHFIELD'S INVESTMENT POLICY

City Attorney John Singler provided a sample ordinance and recommended that the City of Northfield adopt a similar ordinance specifying who has the authority to administer city investments and how city investments are made. Mr. Walker volunteered to review the sample ordinance and draft a proposed Northfield ordinance for Council's consideration.
