MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING

of the City of Northfield Council January 22, 2018

Pursuant to written notice, the regular meeting of the City of Northfield Council was held on Monday, January 22, 2018, at the Fenley Office Park, 4965 U.S. Highway 42. Council members present: Sharon Berger, Alan Birch, Steve Levy, Clark Rhea and Tracy Walker. City officials present: Mayor Randolph Chappell, Police Chief Richard Frank, Treasurer Charles Veeneman, City Engineer Phil Hasselwander and City Clerk Phyllis Onachilla. Also present: Brandon Smith, and Tom and Diana Eifler, Northfield residents.

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m., by Mayor Chappell.

APPOINTMENT OF NEW COUNCIL MEMBER

At the November 2017 council meeting, Mr. White announced his resignation as Council Member for the City of Northfield. It was moved by Ms. Berger and seconded by Mr. Levy that the City of Northfield accept Mr. White's resignation. Council members voting in favor of this motion: Berger, Birch, Levy, Rhea and Walker. Motion carried.

Mayor Chappell recommended Northfield resident Brandon Smith to fill Mr. White's unexpired term on the city council. It was moved by Ms. Berger and seconded by Mr. Birch that Brandon Smith be appointed Council Member for the City of Northfield to fill Mr. White's unexpired term. Council members voting in favor of this motion: Berger, Birch, Levy, Rhea and Walker. Motion carried.

The City Clerk, being a Notary Public, administered the Oath of Office to Brandon Smith, newly-appointed Council Member for the City of Northfield.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Council members reviewed the Income Statement for the General Fund for the month ending December 31, 2017, the Balance Sheet and the City's List of Investments for the General Fund as of December 31, 2017. They also reviewed the Income Statement and the Balance Sheet for the Road Fund for the month ending December 31, 2017, the General Ledger and the Check Register from December 1 through December 31, 2017.

POLICE REPORT

Police Chief Richard Frank briefed council members on recent activities throughout the city including two burglaries; one on Wynnewood Circle and one in the 2300 block of Stannye Drive. There were eight citations issued this month.

OLD BUSINESS

NORTHFIELD TREE PROGRAM

Mr. Walker informed the Council that, through the current Northfield Tree Program, 54 trees were planted within the City.
