- Northfield Office Condo Project: Public meeting and office location under discussion.
 Note that the Fenley Office Park will not be available for our Police as of August 2022.
 - The Mayor will contact other cities about the possibility of shared office space, and will also find out the archival requirements for Police documents.
- Property Use Violations: Randy contacted Code Enforcement. One item abated, 2nd item pending resolution. MCE work is still in progress.
- Lime Ridge Sidewalk, Northfield will have access.
- Echo Tech: has the additional truck been implemented?
- Stop sign at Northfield Court:
 - The number of speeding incidents has decreased since the school year ended (not as much traffic).
 - The city will order a stop sign (due to lead time) in case the issue reoccurs at the start of school in the Fall.
